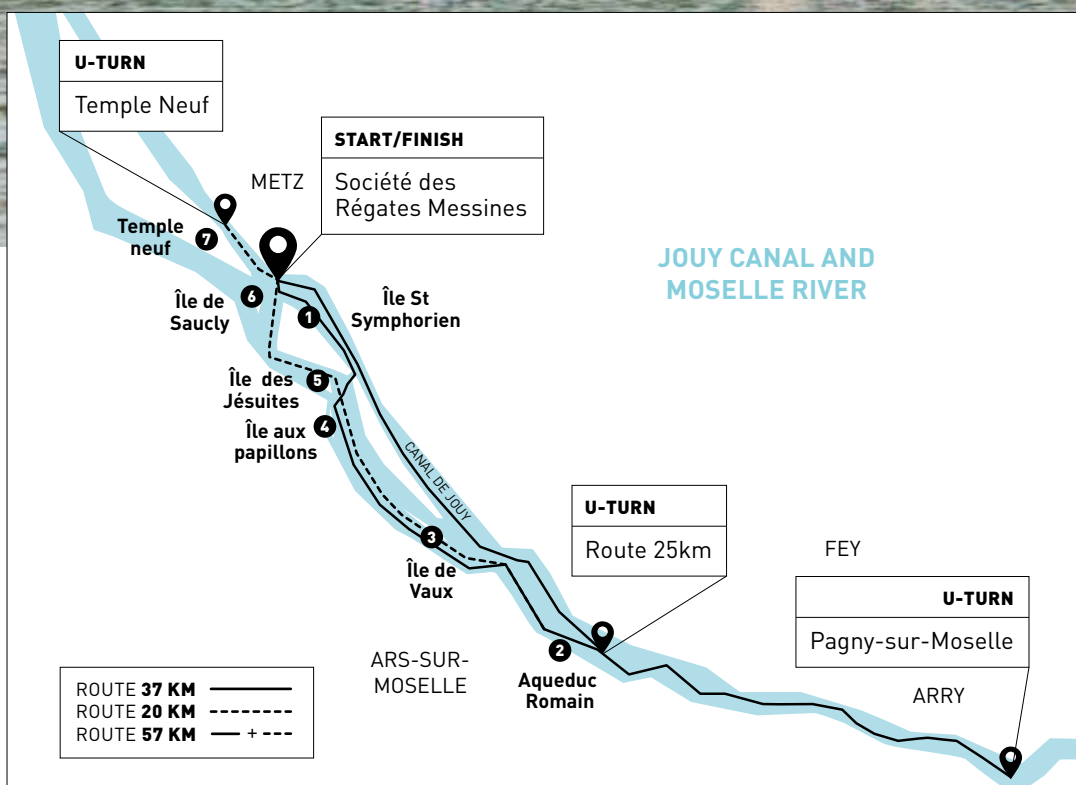

Our rowing tour allows you to discover the city of Metz and its surroundings on the Moselle river, through two intertwined routes. Either 57 km for the bolder ones, or 25 km for the less experienced. Boats will be launched on the Jouy canal, a "green corridor" which brings joy to walkers and sports fans. You will join the Moselle river at Jouy-aux-Arches, boasting its Roman aquaduct, to navigate to Pagny-sur-Moselle. The next part of the route takes place completely on the Moselle river and its branches that feed the water body of Metz and you will enjoy a surprising view of the city and our club.

## PROVISIONAL PLANNING

**7.00 AM** Meeting point at the Société des Régates Messines (SRM) and briefing of the skippers and club representatives.

**7.45 AM** Boat launching on the Jouy canal, for a 37/57 or 25-km tour.

**1.00 PM** Lunch at the SRM base.

**2.45 PM** Departure from the club for a 20/57-km tour or guided visit of Metz for those who took part in the 25-km tour.

**5.30 PM** Arrival on the waterbody in Metz and friendly drink.

For the accompanying persons, trip on an electrical boat in the morning, guided walking visit of Metz in the afternoon.
